HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may kindly be permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage to approach the higher authorities of the respondent-Board to make out a case that the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of grant of leave encashment in respect of the leave which was accumulated throughout the service career of the petitioner.

this stage may kindly be allowed with the liberty as prayed for.
