The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.131 dated 21.12.2015 at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana, under Sections 364/34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act (Sections 302/396/397/412/120-B/201 IPC added later on).

Today, at the very outset, learned State counsel has informed that in the instant case the prosecution evidence stands concluded and in fact statements of the accused in terms of Section 313 Cr.P.C. have already been recorded.

Learned counsel for the complainant, who is also present, has informed that in fact the matter is fixed before the trial Court today itself for arguments.

In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is virtually at its fag end, this Court does not find any ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage. The petition, as such, is dismissed.

However, in case there is any inordinate delay in conclusion of trial, it shall always be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
