Affidavit has been filed by the State which is taken on record.

Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab while referring to the affidavit has stated that the petitioner did not supply his correct address where he wishes to go after getting parole for a period of 8 weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the aforesaid position, she may be permitted to withdraw the present petition in order to enable the petitioner to file a fresh application for grant of parole before the Competent Authority by supplying the correct address of the petitioner. She submitted that in case now the petitioner files an application, then some time bound direction may be issued for deciding the same.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and in view of the aforesaid factual position, the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner for withdrawal of the present petition is accepted. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a fresh application by supplying fresh address to the concerned Competent Authority and in the event of filing such fresh application, then the same shall be considered and decided by the Competent Authority afresh and in accordance with law and within a period of three weeks thereafter.

The present petition stands disposed of.
