1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.02.2022, in CRWP-716-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 08.02.2022, reveals that CRWP-716-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the matter and to decide representation dated 07.01.2022, as regards the alleged threat perception to the petitioner as well as of other members of his family, expeditiously in accordance with law and in case it was found that there was any genuine threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner or any member of his family, to take necessary steps to ensure that no harm was caused to the petitioner or to any of his family members.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply alongwith copy of statement of the petitioner of his being satisfied with the report Annexure R-1 dated 22.10.2022 on the basis of investigation. The same is

taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the circumstances he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
