SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

Report dated 24.11.2022, of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamanon, has been received, wherein it has been mentioned that the complainant Gagandeep Singh had appeared on 12.10.2022 and make a separate statement, wherein it has been recorded that no compromise has ever been effected between the parties and his signatures were obtained on the blank papers by the accused persons for filing of quashing under coercion by putting pressure of my relatives present there. He also submits in his statement dated 12.10.2022, that he has no knowledge as to what has been written in the alleged compromise.

Since, the complainant himself has appeared in person and denied the execution of such compromise, the present petition deserves to be

dismissed having been filed on the surmises of compromise between the parties, which amounts to an abuse of process of law.

Hence, the same is dismissed with cost of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited in the High Court Lawyer's Welfare Fund.
