As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.2.5 lakhs (Two lakhs fifty thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to respondents No.1 to 3 as full and final settlement of the cross-objections in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellants within a period of five weeks.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.2.5 lakhs in the name of respondents No.1 to 3 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 5 weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company.

Respondents No.1 to 3, counsel/(respondents No.1 to 3) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.

The present appeal is disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.4-Insurance Company.

Respondent No.4-Insurance Company shall waive off its recovery right against the appellant herein.
