Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 261 dated 12.09.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 23.12.2020, parties were directed to appear before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the Magistrate was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.
