By this common order, above mentioned writ petitions are being disposed off as all the writ petitions involve same question of law.

In this bunch of writ petitions, the petitioners are claiming promotion to the post of Principal under 20% quota available for Headmasters, which according to the petitioners has not been filled up by the respondents and that too without any valid justification.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed a short reply, wherein, it has been mentioned that provisional seniority list of the Head Masters cadre is under consideration and the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Principal under 20% quota will be considered after

the finalization of the seniority list. The said reply was filed by the respondents in August, 2018.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the claim of the petitioners as raised in the present writ petitions, has not been considered by the respondents so far, the same will be considered by them and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present writ petitions may be disposed off having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
