HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 10 dated 12.01.2019, under Sections 326, 325, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 01.12.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 23.12.2021 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between the parties apparently appears to be genuine.

FIR was registered on 12.01.2019, whereas the compromise has been effected between the parties on 13.08.2021. During this period the investigation was concluded and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has also been filed. The trial commenced and the case is at the stage of prosecution evidence. The compromise was effected between the parties about 2 ½ years after the registration of FIR. In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 10 dated 12.01.2019, under Sections 326, 325, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed subject to the petitioners depositing a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only) each with the Director PGIMER, Chandigarh Poor Patient Welfare Fund.
