These petitions have been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioners in case FIR No. 0015, dated 28.01.2020, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 302/34 of the IPC.

The replies filed on behalf of the respondent-State are ordered to be taken on record.

Pursuant to the last order passed, the report of the learned trial court dated 02.03.2022 has been received, stating therein that 09 prosecution witnesses including the complainant and other "private witnesses" have been examined by that court, with witnesses as regards medical evidence and police officials still to be examined.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed, with the orders earlier passed admitting the petitioners to interim bail made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.
