This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 read with Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 bearing No.COMA/3403/2017 dated 29.03.2017 and summoning order dated 31.10.2017.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to them, at the relevant stage before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further made a prayer

that petitioner No.2 is 54 years old and was not a signatory to the cheque and thus, prays that his personal appearance before the trial Court may kindly be exempted.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts as stated by learned counsel for the petitioners, the personal appearance of petitioner No.2 before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner No.2 shall be represented through his counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence, but in the presence of his counsel and will never raise a plea either before the trial Court or in appeals/revisions etc. that the prosecution evidence has been recorded in his absence or the proceedings have been conducted in his absence;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
