It is necessary to note that in FAO No.223 of 2016 (O&M) filed by New India Assurance Company Limited, this Court increased compensation amount to the extent of Rs.2,18,000/- over and above the amount granted by the MACT. Taking note of that, counsel for the parties are in agreement (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) to settle this case. Let, an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- more be paid to the claimants over and above the amount already paid by MACT and enhanced by High Court in the above mentioned case.

Counsel states that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No. 1-Hardeep Kaur. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No. 1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs only) favouring appellant No. 1-Hardeep Kaur widow of Late Rashpal Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 24.11.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
