[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.11.2018 in RFA No.2741 of 2006.

[2] Learned AAG has produced compliance report dated 21.11.2022 along with CC Form reflecting payment(s) of Rs.9,41,100/- to the petitioners i.e.Dil Bibi widow of Bashir Mohd. and BinuDeen son of Husain Baksh (adopted son of Bashir Mohd.) respectively in terms of entitlement in LAC Case, award No.118 dated 25.08.1998. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for claiming the statutory benefits where the same have not been released in terms of release order, Annexure P/1.

[3] The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
