1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.04.2022, in CRM-M-15821-2022

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 20.04.2022, reveals that CRM-M-15821-2022, was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 22.01.2022, in accordance with law, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent states that decision has already been taken by the respondent vide Annexure P/3 dated 15.07.2022, therefore, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and the petitioner if so advised may challenge order Annexure P/3 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order Annexure P/3 dated 15.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
