Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though while declaring the revised result, the Commission has mentioned that the same has been done on the basis of the recommendation of the report of the Expert Panel but nothing has been provided so as to ascertain whether, the claim of the petitioners has been considered in the correct perspective or not.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that even the revised answer key has not been made public so as to know which objection of the petitioners stands accepted and which stands rejected, hence, the transparency, which is needed to execute, is missing, which is the grievance of the petitioners in the present petition.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioners have any grievance, the same should be addressed to the Commission by way of representation and in case any such representation is moved by the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law

within a period of two weeks of the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage, with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.
