Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 6 to take remedial action on the complaint dated 17.09.2020 (P-1).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh representation to the Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh and the same be decided within the time bound manner.
