Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against respondent No.5.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is a young lady, was married to Kulwinder Singh and their marriage ended in a panchayati divorce and thereafter, petitioner came in contact with respondent No.5, who deceived her of gold ornaments, money and entered into physical relations with her. Counsel submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) with Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3, but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the

same.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner is just and fair.

Without adverting to the merits of the petitioner's allegations at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) and thereafter, to take appropriate steps as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of this order alongwith copy of representation, Annexure P-1 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, respondent No.3 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
