This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.40 dated 19.06.2014, under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mullanpur Garib Dass, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for appearing on behalf of the complainant has placed on record a copy of order dated 12.04.2022, passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kharar and order dated 14.05.2022, passed by the Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat, which are taken on record and the same have been marked as 'Mark A & Mark B', respectively. It has been pointed out that a compromise has been effected between

petitioner-Vikash Kumar and complainant-Swaranjeet Singh and the matter has been compounded under Section 320 Cr.P.C. and the petitioner Vikash Kumar has been acquitted for the offences, as detailed in the FIR, vide the said order dated 14.05.2022, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said facts.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

It is made clear that in case, any cause survives, it would be open to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, in accordance with law.

Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the aforesaid order.
