Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.174 dated 11.09.2020, under Sections 363 and 366-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Vide order dated 15.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.11.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
