[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.11.2017, in CWP No.16716 of 2015 in case titled as '**P. Ramakrishnan**versus**Union of India and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWPNo.16716 of 2015, was allowed vide order dated 07.11.2017 and the petitioner was held entitled to consideration for promotion to the post of Charge Mechanic. Accordingly, communication dated 16.01.2013 was set aside and the respondents directed to re-consider the petitioner's name for promotion to the post of Charge Mechanic and hold DPC if the petitioner was otherwise eligible as in October / November, 2008.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that benefits as per entitlement having been granted to the petitioner in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 07.11.2017 in CWP No.16716 of 2015, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be

permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
