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VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking to quash FIR No. 09 dated 07.01.2020 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC registered at Police Station City II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that no compromise has been effected between the parties.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the amicable settlement has been effected through mediation in this Court and furthermore, the petitioner is complying with the terms and conditions of the compromise.

As the respondent No.2 has backed out of the compromise, learned counsel for the petitioners seek to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law for quashing the FIR on merits.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
