The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.478 dated 29.10.2020 under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Palam Vihar, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 21.11.2020.

Learned State counsel submits that in all there are 19 prosecution witnesses out of which 12 have already been examined and rest of the witnesses are only formal witnesses.

In view of the above position, this court is of the view that trial being at the fag end, this is not the appropriate stage for entertaining this petition, however, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner, learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.
