[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-4, dated 02.02.2022, in CWP No.1010 of 2022 in case titled as '**Jai Bhagwan and another**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-4) reveals that CWP No.1010 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide both representations dated 10.09.2020 filed by the petitioners by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of an order adverse to the interest to the petitioners, by passing a speaking order.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 17.10.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on

in representations dated 10.09.2020 having been rejected vide order dated 17.10.2022, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but pray for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 17.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
