[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against
the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-
1, dated 21.02.2022, in CRM-M No.30987 of 2021in case titled as
'Dayjee Sharma*versus*State of Haryana and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CRM-
MNo.30987 of 2021was disposed of by directing the official respondents
to conclude further investigations, and on conclusion of the same, the
Investigating Officer was directed either to file cancellation report before
the concerned learned Magistrate or an affirmative report under Section
173 Cr.P.C..

[3] At the outset, learned counsel states that in view of
cancellation report having been filed by the respondents before the Court
of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula on 17.10.2022 and the case
now being listed for hearing on 06.12.2022, he does not press the instant

petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
