1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orderAnnexure P-1, dated 28.04.2022 in CWP No.8813 of 2022.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.8813 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 15.01.2022 within eight weeks from the date of receipt of order.

3. Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 07.09.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 15.01.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstance, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 07.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
