[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.05.2021, whereby directions were issued to the respondent to mark the case arising out of FIR No.149 dated 19.09.2013 registered under Sections 420, 457, 380, 201, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana to any Senior Police Officer for further investigation.

[3] At the outset, learned State Counsel has placed on record copy of order dated 09.11.2021 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, marking the case for further investigation to Smt. Pragya Jain, ADCP, Security and Operation, Ludhiana. The same is taken on record.

[4] Learned State Counsel states that in the circumstances, order

of the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Ludhiana dated 20.05.2021 having been complied with, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

[5] Faced with the aforementioned position and after perusal of order dated 09.11.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent. Contempt petition is *disposed of*, accordingly.
