Through this third petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.82 dated 19.03.2021, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh Sadar, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 (506 IPC added later on).

As per the office report, notice could not be issued to respondent No.2 for want of process fee.

At this stage, Mr. Chandandeep Singh, Advocate, puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 23.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioners have handed over a demand draft, amounting to Rs.9,50,000/- to respondent No.2-complainant, and that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ashok, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and are now not required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that respondent No.2 has received the demand draft, amounting to Rs.9,50,000/- from the petitioners.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.09.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
