Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 04.11.2017 (P-3), 23.11.2015 (P-7), legal notice dated 20.01.2016 (P-9) and regularize the services of petitioner.

In pursuance of order dated 13.05.2022, respondents have passed the order dated 05.07.2022 and relevant portion of the same reads as under:-

“Whereas, as per Punjab Govt. Instructions No.15/53/2005-4PP-3/18272 dated 15.12.2006 and in compliance to Chief Engineer/RSDC, Irrigation Works, Punjab Shahpurkandi Township office letter No.29300-40 dated 10.09.2007, the service of petitioner had been regularized as Workmistry w.e.f. 17.10.2007 vide this office letter No.1432/1433-35/5-EG dated 17.10.2007.

Whereas, the petitioner was appointed as Beldar on dated 22.01.1988 and subsequently promoted as Workmistry w.e.f. 01.03.1995.

Whereas, as per the policy dated 23.01.2001 and in compliance of orders passed by Hon'ble High Court in CWP No.8666 of 2017 and Chief Engineer/Dams, Water Resources Department, Punjab Shahpurkandi office letter No.12560-61/LC/4285 dated 01.07.2022, the services of the petitioner deserves to be regularized w.e.f. 23.01.2001. Therefore the service of petitioner had already been regularized as Workmistry w.e.f. 17.10.2007 vide this office letter No.1432/1433-35/5-EG dated 17.10.2007 is hereby superseded.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and it has been found that the petitioner has become eligible for regularizing his service w.e.f. 23.01.2001 in the post of Workmistry. Hence his service are hereby regularized w.e.f. 23.01.2001."

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly stated that since his claim regarding regularization w.e.f. 23.01.2001 has been accepted, therefore, petition be disposed off.

Ordered accordingly.
