1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 07.07.2022, in CWP-14233-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveal that CWP-14233-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 01.06.2022 and pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has filed reply. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order Annexure R/1 dated 23.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 01.06.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 23.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
