MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.90 dated 09.09.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 452, 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 16.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel has placed reliance upon the order dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed in CRM-M-44296-2021 in respect of co-accused, who have already been granted concession of pre-arrest bail. Notice of motion for 21.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. To be heard along with CRM-M- 44296-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Sukhdev Raj states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.11.2021 is made absolute.
