The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to finalize his promotion case pending before respondent No.2 since 28.08.2021 seeking promotion to the post of Senior Scientific Officer (Serology) w.e.f. 13.06.2021, the date when he became eligible.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this respect, the petitioner has already given a representation dated 21.04.2022, Annexure P-6, to respondent No.1, but no response has been received till date. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his representation is decided while affording him personal hearing, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide representation dated 21.04.2022, Annexure P-6, of the petitioner while affording him personal hearing. The petitioner shall appear before respondent No.1 on 27.09.2022 or any other date convenient to respondent No.1, who shall decide his representation within a period of one month thereafter, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
