Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to compute the entire length of service/ contract period/ contract service of the petitioners to consider as regular and satisfactory service and to accord seniority and all consequential benefits to the petitioners with effect from the date of their joining on contract basis.

Petitioner is stated to have been appointed as Math Mistress on contract basis on 08.10.1997. Her services were regularized from 01.10.2003, vide order dated 20.01.2004. Legal notice dated 27.08.2021, Annexure P-6, is stated to have been served upon the respondents when her representations were not heeded to, but again to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however restricts the claim in this petition to petitioner being considered for grant of deemed date of

appointment with effect from the date candidates selected pursuant to same advertisement were afforded appointment, solely for the purpose of being considered under the Old Pension Scheme. It is further submitted that petitioner does not seek benefit of seniority, arrears etc., and at this stage petitioner seeks a decision of this claim of hers expeditiously in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the State does not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider this writ petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner to the limited extent as above and decide the same by passing a speaking order expeditiously and preferably within three (03) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
