The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 22.4.2018 registered under sections 307, 326A, 498-A IPC (Section 302 IPC was added later on) at Police Station, Nathana, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars for the last about 4 years. However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh submits that out of the total 20 prosecution witnesses 19 have already been examined and the case is fixed for 12.7.2022 for examining the remaining witness.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, this court does not find it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner when the trial is virtually at the fag end. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
