This petition is filed for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner for a period of seven days, as the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 30th October, 2022.

Notice in the application was issued on 22nd September, 2022 and learned State counsel sought time to file reply.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh submits that though there was a confusion in the affidavit dated 16th October, 2022 filed. Now the factum of marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is verified and same is fixed for 30th October, 2022. He further submits that petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Considering the facts and circumstances in totality, the petitioner is granted interim regular bail for seven days w.e.f. 26th October, 2022 to 1st November, 2022, subject to furnishing of surety bonds of Rs.50,000/- with the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned. He shall report back to the Jail authorities as per the jail timings.

The petition is allowed.
