The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to file the final report in case bearing FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2019 under Section 452, 427, 336, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 326 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Sukhpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Baba Bakala Sahib Amritsar (Rural) dated 29.07.2022 has been filed today in Court. Copy thereof has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner. The relevant extract of the same reads thus:-

15. That an Investigation report/Challan under section 173 Cr.P.C in the main case (FIR No. 01 dated 01.01.2019) has been submitted in the learned court of Area Judicial Magistrate, Judicial Complex Baba Bakala Sahib on 12.05.2022 against the accused Shiv Singh son of Karnail Singh, Jagroop Singh son of Kabal Singh and Narinder Singh

son of Chanchal Singh. A total of 16 prosecution witness have been cited in the aforesaid Investigation Report/Challan.

16. That an Investigation report/Challan under section 173 Cr.P.C in the cross case (GDR No. 13 dated 05.01.2019) has also been submitted in the learned court of Area Judicial Magistrate, Judicial Complex Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar on 12.05.2022 against the petitioner, Dalbir Singh son of Surjit Singh, Paramjit Kaur wife of Dalbir Singh, Gurmeet Singh son of Ajaib Singh, Manjit Singh son of Ajaib Singh and Gagandeep Singh son of Dalbir Singh. A total of 14 prosecution witness have been cited in the aforesaid Investigation Report/Challan.

In view of the above, the prayer made by the petitioner stands answered.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
