Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.142 dated 17.07.2022, registered under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

After arguing for some time and after seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further made a prayer that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the police and files an application for grant of regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of five days from the date of filing of the said application.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Petitioner is directed to surrender within a period of 10 days from today and in case, after surrendering before the police, the petitioner files an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of five days from the date of filing of the said application.
