Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 26.08.2011 (P-2) for employment on compassionate ground.

Paper-book reveals that grievance of the petitioner is pending since August, 2011.

In view of above, this Court deems it appropriate to issue a mandate to the aforesaid respondent.

As a result thereof, without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Department of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated

26.08.2011 (P-2) by passing reasoned order as per law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
