Learned State counsel in the light of the affidavit of Mr. Gurmeet Singh, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Mamdot dated 26th September, 2019 submits that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous as on demarcation 33 persons have found to be in illegal possession of the Gram Panchayat land against whom proceedings under Section 7 of Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 have been initiated. She further informs that the next date of hearing before the competent authority is 1st August, 2022.
