On 28.02.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

been amicably settled and the insurer will pay an amount of
Rs.60000/- in total to satisfy the claimants.*

The offer is acceptable to the appellant.

*Let the amount of Rs.60000/- be paid to the
claimantappellant by respondent No.3 within a period of four
weeks from today.*

Adjourned to 21.04.2020.”

Today, learned counsel for respondent No.3 has produced the payment details of Rs.60,000/- made through a cheque bearing No.323862 dated 24.07.2020 in favour of claimant/appellant Vinod Kumar.

In view of above, the claim of enhancement of compensation does not survive any more and the appeal is disposed of.
