In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they have not completed 05 years tenure at the present place of posting but still they have been transferred to another place, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that once the similarly situated employees, who were also posted along with the petitioners have more tenure than the petitioners at the present station, have been retained, then transferring the petitioners out of the said station is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners by filing various representations with the respondents, copies of

which have been attached with the present petition as Annexures P-5 to P-9, which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case the same are decided by the respondents expeditiously by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that representations of the petitioners as Annexures P-5 to P-9 will be decided within a period of three weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
