Learned counsel for the appellant states that these appeals may be
disposed of with liberty to the appellant to move an appropriate application
before the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, for granting them

permanent recognition for running the school in the premises in question as he asserts that now the appellant has got the required norms as per the Haryana School Education Rules as amended on 21.05.2021. He further states that some time-frame be given for consideration of the application to be submitted by the appellant and for decision thereon.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the appellant, we dispose of these appeals by giving liberty to the appellant to file an appropriate application in the required proforma to the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, within a period of one week from today. The said application shall be supported with documentary evidence in support of the statements made in the application.

In case of submission of such an application, fulfilling all the requirements as may be prescribed for a complete application to be considered, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of complete application form.

The decision which will be taken by the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, shall be conveyed to the appellant within a further period of one week. It goes without saying that it should be a speaking order.

It is made clear that no admissions are permitted to be made by the appellant in the school till the permanent recognition is granted by the State of Haryana.

It may be added here that the subsequent process of recognition would only start after the permanent affiliation is granted by the State of Haryana.

In the light of the disposal of the appeals, pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
