Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-7086-2020, titled as “Amandeep Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others”, dated 01.04.2021, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

*“In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, without commenting on the merits of the case or on the entitlement of the petitioners regarding the relief claimed, the present civil writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision in accordance with law on the Legal Notice dated 18.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and, in any case, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and in case the petitioners are held entitled to the relief claimed, the same be released within a period of two months thereafter.
Disposed off accordingly.”*

In reply, learned counsel for the respondents on instructions

submits that a policy decision in this regard is likely to be taken within a period

of eight weeks, from today.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of.

The petitioners shall be at liberty to move an application for revival if the decision is not taken.
