The present petition has been filed seeking the grant of child care leave from 29.09.2022 to 26.05.2023 i.e. for a period of 240 days as the infant child of the petitioner needs intensive care keeping in view the fact the child is suffering from Breath Holding Spell (BHS) and the petitioner needs to remain present with her child due to the said ailment.

Learned State counsel submits that though 240 days' child care leave as being asked for has not been given to the petitioner at a stretch but leave for a period of 60 days has been extended to the petitioner and in case, the situation does not improve or the petitioner needs further leave and if an application is made to the said effect by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law as well as the factual aspect.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the order dated 28.09.2022 passed by the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy in case, further leave is needed keeping in view the facts and circumstances.

Ordered accordingly.
