Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for directing respondent No.3 to get a fair and unbiased investigation/inquiry conducted in the complaints dated 06.01.2022 and 26.05.2022, Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively, submitted by the petitioner and to take action against private respondents No.6 to 8.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's marriage was solemnized with Harwinder Singh on 20.06.2021 and despite the fact that sufficient dowry was given at the time of marriage, private respondents, who are husband and in-laws, were not satisfied with the same. She was ill-treated and was being forced to make physical relations with a close relative. Counsel submits that petitioner has also made a reference to specific incident which took place with her. He submits that petitioner has

submitted various complainants with official respondents, but no action has been taken.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 5 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr.P.S.Grewal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Considering the nature of prayer made, petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior superintendent of Police, Moga-respondent No.4 to examine the complaint dated 26.05.2022 (Annexure P-2) and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
