SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C., for quashing of FIR No.37 dated 20.02.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 306, 420, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Samrala, Police Distt. Khanna, District Ludhiana, including order of framing of charges (Annexure P-11) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh S/o Tara Singh R/o Village Daudpur, Tehsil Samrala, District Ludhiana, Punjab, stating therein that statement with regard to compromise was got recorded before learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samrala on 03.10.2017, which is placed on record as Annexure P-8. Compromise dated 23.05.2016 is also on record as Annexure P-6. The said fact has not disputed by the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that the

petitioners do not want to pursue the present petition in view of the said compromise dated 23.05.2016.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. FIR No.37 dated 20.02.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 306, 420, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Samrala, Police Distt. Khanna, District Ludhiana, with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including order of framing of charges (Annexure P-11), is hereby quashed on the basis of compromise dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-6).
