The matter has been taken up through video conferencing. -

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 265 dated 05.09.2021 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 452, 341, 148, 149 and 427 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, district Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter between the petitioner and the complainant has been compromised and in pursuance thereto a quashing petition has also been filed before this Court.

Learned State counsel acknowledges the above fact.

In the light of the above, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in the petitioner's custodial interrogation and accordingly, subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions

provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in the aforesaid FIR, he shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

The petition is allowed in the above terms.
