1. The petitioner, by filing the present petition cast under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 of 27.03.2020, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, wherein an offence constituted, under Section 379-B of IPC, is embodied.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits, that he has no instructions despite making repeatedly calls, upon, the petitioner. He further submits that, a missing report in respect of the disappearance of the present petitioner has been registered at the police station concerned. Given the above, the personal appearance of the petitioner, upon a Court notice, being served, upon him, also cannot be endeavoured by this Court. Moreover, the learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to state to this Court, whether the order made by this Court, on 09.05.2022, has been meted compliance.

3. In consequence to the above, it appears that it is not possible for the investigating officer concerned, to ensure any co-operation being rendered to him, by the present petitioner, though, co-operation in respect of the relevant offence, at the instance, of the petitioner, to the investigating

officer concerned, was imperative. Therefore, this Court is constrained to, in the face of the above facts, dismiss the present bail petition.

4. Dismissed.
5. However, liberty reserved to the petitioner to re-access this Court, but at an appropriate stage.
