In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents be directed to grant the difference of the salary on re-employment along with arrears as the same has not been released to him for the period from 01.10.2016 to 27.04.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the notice of motion has been issued but the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) wherein also, the same grievance has been raised by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 15.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 15.01.2020 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 15.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
