1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure A-1, dated 20.07.2021, in CRM-M-26083-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure A-1, dated 20.07.2021, reveals that CRM-M-26083-2021, was disposed of on the stand of the State that the inquiry pending in the matter, would be completed within three weeks.

3. Compliance report has been filed along with order Annexure R1/T dated 06.09.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition but prays for permission to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order Annexure R1/T dated 06.09.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
