This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 67 dated 26.07.2017 under Sections 307-A, 279, 337, 338 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bariwala, District Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

On 05.01.2021, none had appeared on behalf of respondent No. 2. Even on 23.02.2021 and on 30.03.2022, non one had appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 in spite of the report of the registry that respondent No. 2 has been served. Even today, the case has been called twice but no one has appeared on behalf of either of the parties. The FIR has been registered under Section 304-A among other sections.

As per the Division Bench judgment of this Court in ***Baldev Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*** reported as **2016(3)**

Law Herald 2020, a petition for quashing on the basis of compromise under Section 304-A is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
